Scholarships with January Deadlines:

GE Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program

- Deadline: January 9, 2014
- Requirements: Applicants must demonstrate the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship at school, at the workplace and in the community. Applicants must demonstrate strong academic performance with a minimum 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale), demonstrate financial need and be US citizens.

- Amount: \$10,000 renewable scholarship (\$40,000 total)

Ron Brown Scholar Program

- Deadline: January 9, 2014
- Requirements: Applicants must be African-American high school seniors who will make significant contributions to society. Applicants must excel academically, exhibit exceptional leadership potential, participate in community service activities and demonstrate financial need. The applicant must be a US citizen or hold a permanent resident visa card.

- Amount: \$10,000 renewable scholarship (\$40,000 total)

Burger King Scholars Program

- Deadline: January 9, 2014
- Requirements: Applicants must have a cumulative high school 2.5 GPA (4.0 scale) and plan to enroll full-time, without interruption, for the entire 2014-2015 academic year at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school. Scholarships will be awarded based on academic record and participation in school and community activities. Only the first 50,000 submitted applications will be processed.

Asian and Pacific Islander American Scholarship Fund

- Deadline: January 9, 2014
- Requirements: Applicants must be of Asian and/or Pacific Islander ethnicity as defined by the U.S. Census, be a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident of the United States, have a minimum 2.7 GPA (4.0 scale) and submit a letter of recommendation online.

Kelly Lynn Lutz Memorial Scholarship

- Deadline: January 10, 2014
- Requirements: Applicants must have lost the life of at least one parent to cancer before the age of 22. Applicants must attend a two- or four-year higher education establishment, have an interest in education, arts, environment, math, or science, show service involvement in the community, church, school, or other non-curricular activity and demonstrate financial need.

- Deadline: January 13, 2014
- Requirements: Applicants must submit a photo, artwork or computer graphic for the front of a greeting card. Photo, art or graphics submitted must be your own original work/creation.

The Tom Joyner Foundation Full Ride Scholarship

- Deadline: January 15, 2014
- Requirements: Applicants must have a minimum 3.5 GPA (4.0 scale), and a minimum 2100 SAT score (combined math, essay and verbal) or ACT score of 30 and be accepted into a Historically Black College or University by July 1, 2014. Applicants must have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities.

- Requirements: Applicants must be high school seniors who have participated in a college readiness program(ex: Upward Bound) in grades 11 and 12, have a minimum 2.4 GPA (4.0 scale) and demonstrate financial need.

Mas Family Scholarship

Deadline: January 15, 2014

- Requirements: Applicants must be Cuban-American students who were born in Cuba or are direct Cuban descendents, have a minimum 3.5 GPA (4.0 scale) and demonstrate financial need. Scholarships are awarded based on academic performance, leadership qualities, potential to contribute to the advancement of a free society, and likelihood of succeeding in the chosen career.

Gates Millenium Scholars Program

Deadline: January 15, 2014

- Requirements: Applicants must be African American, American Indian Alaska Native, Asian Pacific Islander American or Hispanic American, have a minimum 3.3 GPA (4.0 scale), have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular or other activities and meet the Federal Pell Grant eligibility criteria.

Deadline: January 15, 2014

- Requirements: Applicants must have a minimum of a "C" average in high school classes and a minimum of a "B" average in high school business classes, have 3 letters of recommendation and write a one-page biographical sketch on "Why I am Choosing a Career in Business."
